Since November, SCHS board members Elizabeth Anselmo and Nancy Vaillancourt have joyfully taken on this task. Who better than two genealogy gurus with a passion for organization and State School history? Thanks to their dedicated efforts, we've made impressive strides—even though we recognize there's still work to be done.

In the process, we've uncovered even more stories, photos, and artifacts to share with our visitors. We are also fortunate to have high-quality footage filmed in 2012 through a Minnesota Historical Society grant. With advancements in technology, we hope to give visitors the opportunity to see and hear firsthand memories of former State Schoolers. As time moves forward and the number of living State Schoolers naturally declines, these recordings become even more invaluable. With 10,635 children passing through its doors, there are countless State School stories to be told.
